MONTHLY EVENT IN JAPAN (Oct.2015):- Naha Festival and Giant Tug-of-War

The **Naha Tug of war** (那覇大綱挽?) is an event at the annual festival held in Naha, Okinawa, Japan. A three day extravaganza of parades, dances and fireworks. In this the demonstrations of Okinawan culture can be seen, including dance, music, arts and crafts, food, drink and the world's largest tug-of-war. The tug-of-war's history dates back to the 1600's, with its roots in a religious ritual that took place to pray for a successful crop the following year. The giant rope, which is 186 meters long and 1.56 meters wide weighing over 40 tons, has been certified by the Guinness Book of Records In 1997 as being the largest tug-of-war event in the world. The tug-of-war takes place on the 10th of October.





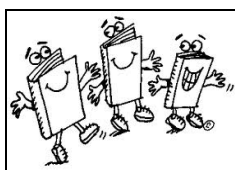
