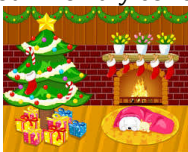


ORIENTATION PROGRAM by SHIZUOKA UNIVERSITY (Japan) ON 7th NOV, 2015

They have a custom to eat toshikoshi soba (year-end buckwheat noodles) on New Year's Eve. They listen to one hundred and eight strokes of the temple bell at night! Why 108 times?? That's because these pearls are said to drive away 108 kinds of our worldly concerns

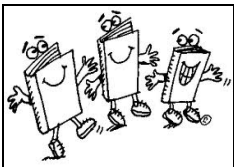
